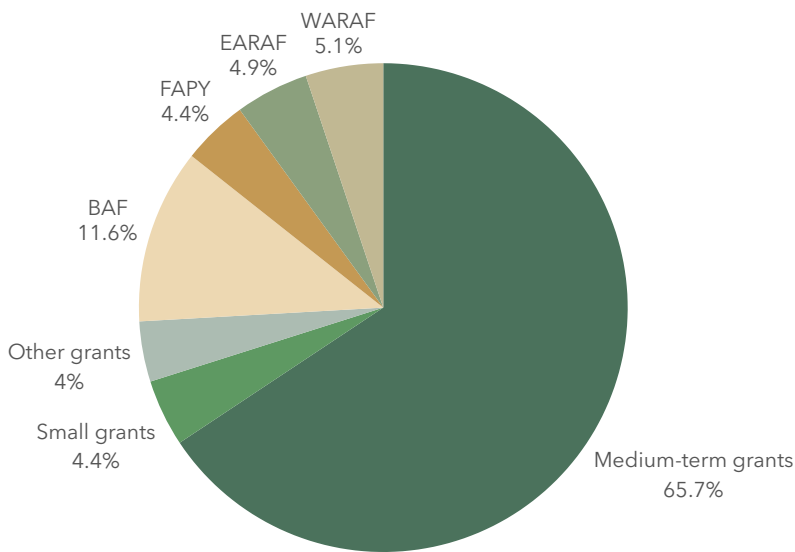




\$14,210,075 through 248 grants for implementation in 66 countries

In 2025, the Agroecology Fund awarded 101 medium-term grants through its global grantmaking program, including 27 renewals and 74 new collaboratives. An additional 35 small grants were made, while the regional funds awarded 106 grants. The total 2025 grantmaking budget reached \$14.2 million, representing a 14.2% increase compared to 2024. The top five recipient countries were India, Mexico, Brazil, Kenya, and Cameroon. Of the medium-term grants, 24% supported initiatives led by women, Indigenous Peoples, or youth-led organizations, and 90% of FAPY's funding supported Indigenous Peoples' initiatives.

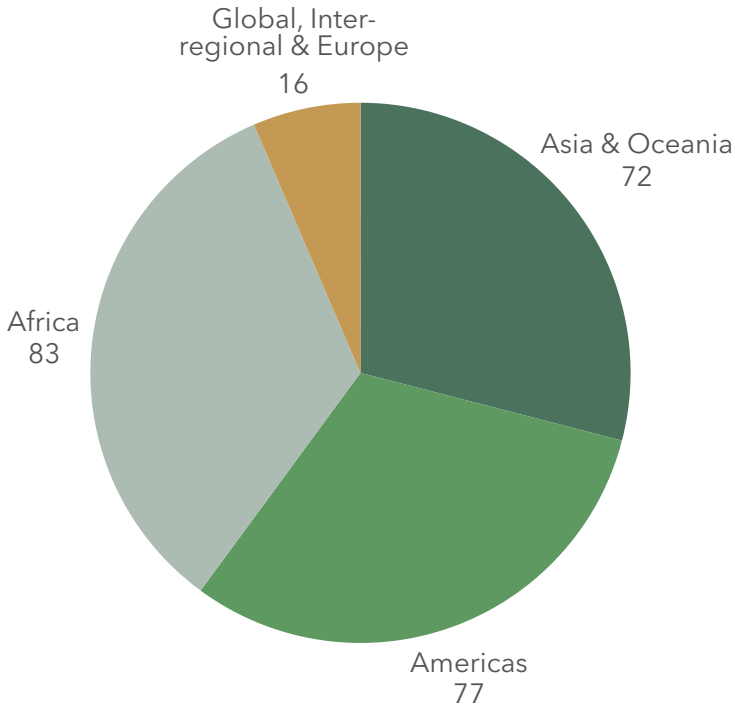
SHARE BY REGION

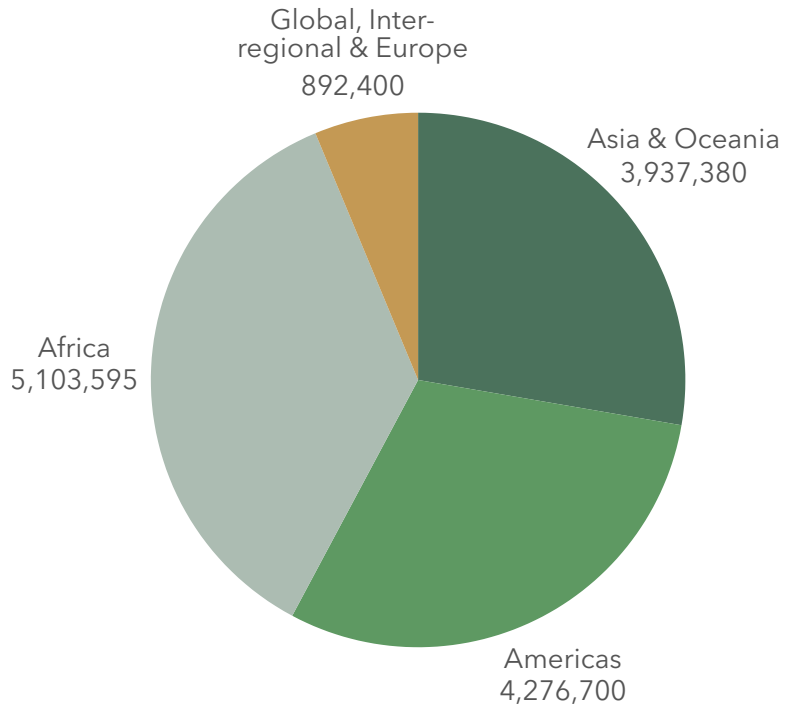

Budget share (US\$)

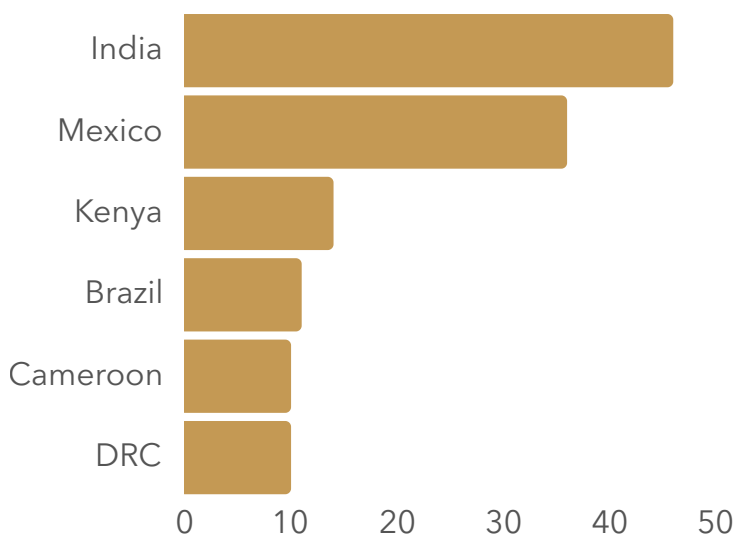

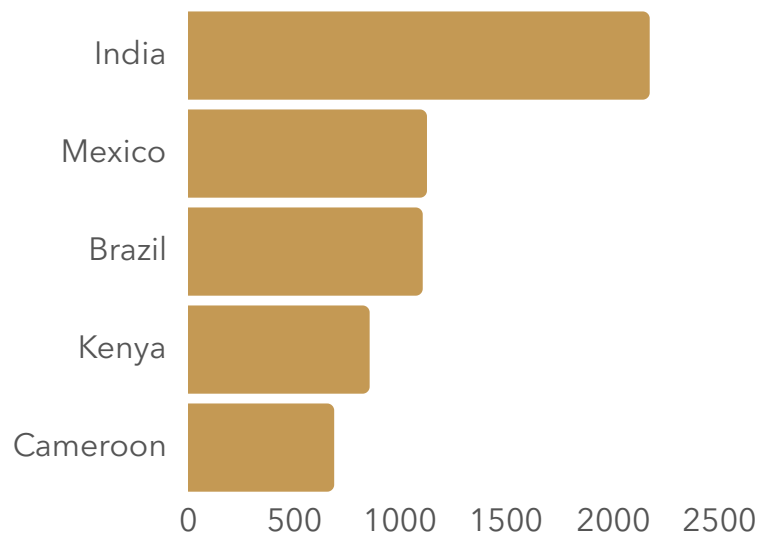
GRANT AND FUNDS RECIPIENTS: TOP 5 COUNTRIES
